




Dean's Mixtures



April (date TBA) we will have an organ crawl in the Lehigh Valley to hear and play some local treasures.


May 27, First Presbyterian Church of Allentown will be our annual banquet and recital, featuring Clara Gerdes, the winner of the regional competition.

The Lehigh Valley is populated by many and varied pipe organs. As time permits, Greg Kuklinski and I are gradually documenting these instruments with photos, stoplists and historic information on

the website. Chapter member, Steven Ziminsky, graciously took time out of his schedule this summer to allow us to photograph and document the II/18 pipe organ at **Grace Lutheran Church, Macungie.**

The builder's plate on the console shows the Fritzsche Organ Company was the last builder to do major work on the instrument. That was in 2001. Recently, the Positiv Flute 4-2 unit was revoiced to make it softer and more useful.
