Bach Marathon Concert

Good news! The LVAGO will be hosting a virtual Bach marathon in March, 2021. The event will take place on Sunday, March 7, beginning at 4:00pm via a Zoom gathering, and continue for no more than 1 1/2 hours, ending by 5:30pm. We are asking each performer to submit their recorded video of organ music



by Bach and/or his predecessors, contemporaries and successors who were inspired by Bach's compositional style and forms. Each submission should last between 10-12 minutes (which is much less performing time than usual), as we must keep the time shorter to allow for more people to participate in this unique virtual performance. There will be brief remarks between performances to introduce the organists and the music they will play.

Performers are asked to record their own videos from the organ of their choice, and to send the video to the program host (tbd) no later than Monday, March 1. You will receive more detailed information in a future email about who will be hosting the Zoom gathering. In addition to your recorded music, please include the composer's name and dates; the title and BWV number, if needed; the place of performance and the builder of the organ; plus a short biography of the performer.

You may send the written information to: Lou Carol Fix, email: lcbfix@gmail.com by Sunday, February 28 to be included in a printed program. Again, please keep your recorded videos to a total time limit of 10-12 minutes. We thank all performers in advance for their willingness to participate in this unique Bach marathon in 2021, and look forward to hearing wonderful and inspiring organ music to help celebrate the birthday of J.S. Bach.
