Bach Marathon Review

Our Chapter's annual Bach birthday celebration took place on Sunday afternoon, March 3, at College Hill Presbyterian Church in Easton and was a wonderful afternoon of beautiful music performed by four organists. Titled "Bach's Big Baroque Birthday Blast," the audience enjoyed works by Bach as well as compositions by those who were influenced by the great master. The recital opened with the Alla Breve in D Major, BWV 589, and concluded with the Passacaglia and Fugue in C minor, BWV 582. Performed between these two works were a chorale prelude, O Ewigkeit, du Donnerwort, by Bach's student Johann Ludwig Krebs; the French Suite in G Major, BWV 816, played on double harpsichord; Allegro from Organ Concerto in A minor (based on Vivaldi's Concerto for Two Violins), BWV 593; Variation from Sonata No. 6 in D minor, op. 65, by Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy based on the chorale "Vater unser im Himmelreich," which was immediately followed by Bach's setting of the chorale for manualiter from the Clavier-Übung III, BWV 683. Special guest speaker, Gordon Maule, offered commentary on the life of J. S. Bach and his importance in history. We thank chapter members who performed in the recital—Christine Clewell, Luke DiGiacinto, Tom Dressler, and Barbara Thomson; as well as Luke DiGiacinto for coordinating the event and Tom Dressler for hosting us at his church.
